There are several things you can do to prepare your home for listing that go beyond adding a fresh coat of paint or new flooring. Follow the tips below to increase your chances of receiving excellent offers and enjoying a seamless transaction. Get ready to make your home shine and attract more loan offers!

Use this checklist to be ready for FHA, USDA & VA offers this s
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Confirm that the property is habitable, with running electricity and water, and all heating and cooling systems are functioning properly.
Ensure that all structures on the property are free of peeling and chipped paint.

- ☐ Verify that the roof is in good condition and free of damage or leaks.
- Ensure that the attic shows no evidence of moisture or mold.
- Confirm that the electrical panel cover is securely attached to the panel.
- Repair or install any missing or loose hand railings on stairs, as well as safety railings on decks and porches.
- ☐ Check for any evidence of wood-destroying pest infestations and address them.
- Replace any broken or damaged windows and doors to ensure proper functionality.
- ☐ Install smoke detectors and carbon monoxide detectors if they are not already present.
- Ensure that any appliances included with the home, such as the refrigerator, stove, dishwasher, and dryer are in good, working condition.
- ☐ Have the water tested before listing the property and rectify any issues identified by the results.
- Know the general location of the well and septic tank.
